

Snowman with Punches
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Supplies:

Punched Shapes:

- Vanilla – 1 3/8 Circle, 1 3/4 Circle
- More Mustard – 1/2 inch Circle, 1 3/8 Circle sliver (see video), Large Star Point
- Night of Navy – 1 3/8 Circle sliver
- Pumpkin Pie – Modern Label
- Ruby Red – Large Oval, Small Oval

Card Material:

- Brocade Blue – 2 1/2 x 2 1/2
- Night of Navy – 2 5/8 x 2 5/8
- More Mustard – 4 x 4
- Ruby Red – 4 1/4 x 8 1/2 scored at 4 1/4
- Playground Button and Linen Thread
- Paper Piercer and Mat Pack
- Sponge and More Mustard Ink, Ruby Red Ink, Night of Navy Ink
- Basic Black Stampin' Write Marker

Steps to Creating this Project:

1. Steps to completing the card front:
 - Sponge each piece of cardstock with the appropriate ink colour. The vanilla uses More Mustard and the other colours are sponged in the matching colour as ink
 - Attach the base of snowman to the Brocade Blue layer, cut off excess that overhangs
 - Attach the snowman head
 - Cut the nose from the Modern Label Punch by using the middle bump (see video for details)
 - Attach the nose
 - Attach the Night of Navy Hat
 - Attach the rim and pom pom
 - Hand draw in the mouth, eyes and buttons
 - Attach the beak to the back of the bird body
 - Attach the bird body and cut off excess
 - Attach the bird wing and cut off excess
 - Hand draw in the eye and the tuft of hair (or feathers 😊)
2. Attach the punched layer to the Night of Navy layer
3. Attach the Night of Navy layer to the More Mustard
4. Paper pierce the More Mustard layer
5. Attach the layers to the Ruby Red card
6. Tie the linen thread through the button
7. Attach the button with a glue dot
