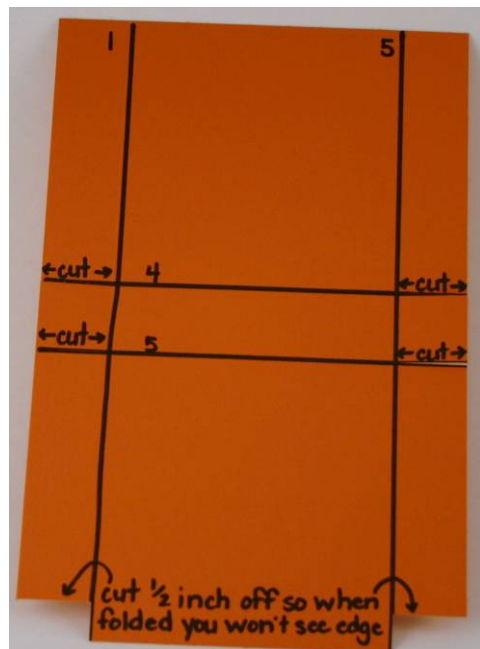

Supply List:

Pumpkin Pie Cardstock - 6 x 9
Soft Sky Cardstock - scraps for flower punch
Old Olive Cardstock - scrap for Word Window Punch
Whisper White Cardstock - scrap for the tag front
Certainly Celery Ink
Old Olive Ink
Spring Break Designer Series Paper - 1 ¾ x 11 (blue dots)
Spring Break Designer Series Paper - ¾ x 11 (green dots)
Blue Bayou Double Stitched Ribbon - 14 inches, 10 inches
Corner Rounder
Tag from On Board Accents
Small Cellophane Bag
Three for You Punch
Word Window Punch
Not Quite Navy Ink
Old Olive Marker
Earth Elements Brads - 3 Not Quite Navy

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Instructions:

1. To create a box that will house an object that is $3\frac{3}{4} \times 3\frac{3}{4}$ or smaller follow these dimensions. To create a bigger box, use the same template but alter your measurements.

- Cut paper to 6 x 9.
- Score at 1 and 5 width wise.
- Score at 4 and 5 length wise.
- Cut along the 1 inch score line on the 4 and 5 inch lines until you hit the vertical score lines (see diagram)
- On the bottom edge of your box, cut off $\frac{1}{2}$ an inch on the tabs. You do not need to do this if you are not scalloping your edge.

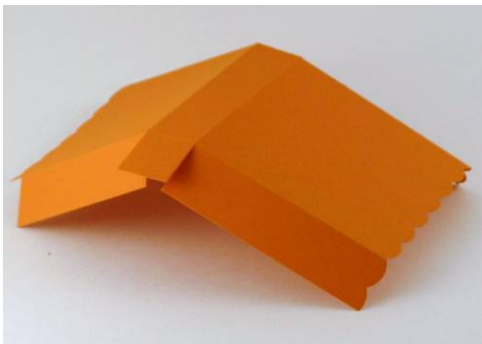


2. Using the corner rounder, scallop your top and bottom edge. To do this, remove the paper guide off the bottom of your punch. Start on one edge and punch. To line up your scallops start the next scallop so there is a slight over lap on the vertex where two scallops will meet. Keep moving across the page. .



3. After both edges are scalloped this is what it should look like.

Note that the top edge starts with a full scallop and ends with a ½ scallop. Note that the bottom scallop also starts with a full scallop and ends with a ½ scallop. This will create a nice finished edge when the box is assembled.



4. To assemble the box, simply fold all the crease lines in. Apply adhesive to the partial long flap (the one you cut the ½ inch off) and the small square flap. Fold box together with the longer edge on the outside and voila you have a box!!!

- To decorate the front of the bag, ink up the alligator in Certainly Celery ink then rock'n'roll it in the Old Olive ink and stamp on Whisper White cardstock.
- Apply to the tag front.
- Using a hobby blade, cut Whisper White cardstock to fit tag front.
- Sponge with Certainly Celery.
- Scallop the green dotted Spring Break Designer Series Paper.
- Adhere the scrapbook paper to the bag, green first then blue.
- Slide ribbon through the tag front and tie around box. Apply some adhesive to hold in place.
- Stamp "Wild About You" in Not Quite Navy on Old Olive cardstock and punch using the Word Window Punch.
- Adhere greeting to the front of the box.
- Punch three flowers using the Three For You Punch in Soft Sky Cardstock.
- Adhere to the box front with 3 Not Quite Navy Brads.
- Hand draw the flower stems using the Old Olive marker.

This box is perfect for homemade cookies, 3x3 notecards, a gift card, a homemade piece of jewellery or something special for that person you are Wild About!
